






MEETING A NATION : WENDAKE

Discover the history, culture, and art of the Huron-Wendat Nation in Wendake, one of the only urban Indigenous communities in Québec. Your immersion experience begins with a visit to the Onhoüa Chetek8e Huron Traditional Site, a reconstitution of a Huron-Wendat village. An Indigenousinspired lunch will be served at the Sagamité Wendake restaurant next to the panoramic Kabir Kouba Falls. In the afternoon, prepare to be delighted by First Nations myths and legends in the Longhouse at Hôtel-Musée Première Nations, a spectacular boutique hotel whose design incorporates Huron-Wendat traditions.

HISTORIC QUÉBEC CITY AND PUBLIC MARKET

Experience the European charm of Old Québec, a UNESCO World Heritage site and the cradle of French civilization in North America. Learn all about Québec City's history and culture, while visiting landmarks including the Fortifications of Québec, the Plains of Abraham, Fairmont Le Château Frontenac and the National Assembly. But don't stop there: this tour takes you outside the walls for an experience of surrounding neighbourhoods. Cap off your tour with a visit to the Grand Marché de Québec, the city's new public market where the region's farmers and artisan producers lay out their wares and visitors can feel the rhythm of the seasons and sample local delicacies.



MONTMORENCY FALLS AND CÔTE-DE-BEAUPRÉ

Drive the New France Route for a trip back through four centuries of history. Begin at the popular Parc de la Chute-Montmorency, with lunch at the elegant Manoir Montmorency. Then, stop in at the Saint-Anne-de-Beaupré Shrine, Albert Gilles copper art studio, and Atelier Paré wood sculpture discovery centre. For a spectacular finish, take the river shuttle back to Québec City.

Trails are accessible in summer and winter alike for a classic hike or a mountain bike or fat bike ride. Other options include canyoning, Via Ferrata, kayaking, snowshoeing and back-country skiing. After lunch, check out Au Chalet en Bois Rond, a resort village with 79 log cottages in natural settings, and a wealth of fun activities for every season.
